**REVISED CRITERIA FOR CLASSIFICATION OF CIVIL DEFENCE TOWNS/DISTRICTS AS FINALISED IN CONSULTATION WITH MINISTRY OF DEFENCE**

1.	<p><u>Category-I:</u></p> <p>Towns/ cities which are located near Atomic Energy Establishments (AEEs) and /or those, if attacked, would have catastrophic effect on National morale owing either to mass destruction or threat to the decision making apparatus of the Nation.</p>
2.	<p><u>Category-II:</u></p> <p>(a) Towns/ areas which are contiguous to military installations; and /or</p> <p>(i) Are likely to aid navigation</p> <p>(ii) Constitute important war effort</p> <p>(b) Towns/ cities with high economic, industrial or military infrastructure, which are assessed as likely high threat enemy missile targets by surface or ship borne weapon systems.</p> <p>(c) Towns/ cities within strike range with a population of more than one lakh and at least 30 Kms away from military installations</p>
3.	<p><u>Category-III:</u></p> <p>(a) Towns/ cities, though not within strike range of an aircraft/ missile but with important civil industrial, economic and military infrastructure, which have high sabotage threat or accidental/ environmental hazards.</p> <p>(b) Towns and cities located in dormant sectors with a population greater than one lakh and have industries which are potential source of hazard/ disasters.</p> <p>(c) Are potential choke points communication</p> <p>(d) Seats of Government</p> <p>(e) Disaster prone area/towns</p>
